CULTURAL EVENTS & TRADITIONS



CREAR hosted six cultural events celebrating local heritage and community bonds, including a concert and art expo showcasing local talent, two traditional tamaladas and a family dinner bringing students and families together, and mascarada to honor Costa Rican culture

EDUCATIONAL ENGAGEMENT

CREAR delivered eight charlas in two local elementary schools, focusing on self-confidence and anti-bullying, to foster personal growth among young students.
